We request that you involve a multidisciplinary team to support in both the diagnosis and intervention planning with both ASD and ADHD. ADHD assessments are usually not recommended for children under school age and if required, a paediatrician referral is a recommended first step.

*May be a delay with this assessment *Psychologists conducting a single clinician diagnostic evaluation are recommended to have a practice endorsement in clinical psychology, educational/developmental psychology or neuropsychology. Reports by Provisionally registered psychologists will also require a secondary sign off by a fully registered psychologist. This may involve an additional wait for the report. Assessments may take a couple of months due to the number of professionals involved and potential delays with communication and receipt of information for next steps
